4.2 – To approve updated/clarified language in the Blue Book to address how cooperative sponsorships are counted in division alignments for sports that combine male and female enrollments for division alignment purposes.

Bylaws - Page 19, #4 - The Conference will .... In sports where transportation is shared by both genders and only 1 coach may be present (Cross Country, Track & Field, Bowling), divisions will be based on combined male and female enrollments and both genders will have the same division alignment. The combined male and female enrollments of schools who are part of a cooperative sponsorship should use the PIAA cooperative sponsorship male enrollment and the PIAA cooperative sponsorship female enrollments when calculating the combined male/female enrollments. ... until the next two (2)-year cycle.
